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### Tea Market Report: Sale 32 of 7th - 9th August 2023

There was improved general demand for the 196,719 packages (13.51m/kgs) on offer with prices closely following quality; 33.12% remained unsold.

#### Leaf Grades (M2)

**Offerings:** 124,619 packages (8.16m/kgs) – 39.19% unsold.

#### BP1

**Best** – Were a strong feature appreciating by up to USC120.

**Brighter** – Most teas were firm to USC30 above previous levels with a few invoices discounted by up to USC21 and select lines lost USC87.

**Mediums** – KTDA mediums varied between USC8 dearer to easier by up to USC10. Plantation mediums were steady to irregularly dearer by up to USC53.

**Lower Medium** – Were irregular ranging between firm to USC21 dearer to easier by up to USC17.

**Plainer** – Varied between steady to USC12 dearer to easier by up to USC18.

#### PF1:

**Best** – Gained up to USC41.

**Brighter** – Were firm to USC38 above last prices.

**Mediums** – KTDA mediums were steady to dearer by up to USC16 while plantation mediums advanced by up to USC14.

**Lower Medium** – Irregular and varied between firm to USC15 dearer

**Plainer** – Were irregular ranging between USC19 dearer to USC22 below previous rates.

#### DUST Grades (M1)

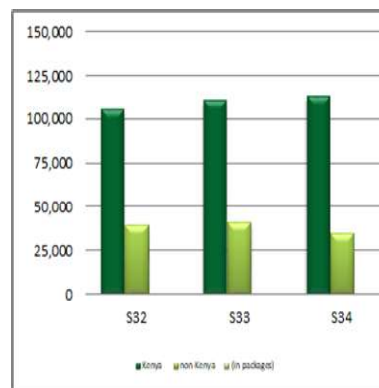
**Offerings:** 72,100 packages (5.35m/kgs) – 29.10% unsold.

#### PDUST:

**Best** – Firm to USC22 dearer.

**Brighter** – Well competed for at steady to USC31 above last levels.

**Mediums** – KTDA mediums were irregular varying between mostly firm to USC7 dearer with selected lines advancing by USC16 to easier by up to USC8; plantation mediums ranged be-



tween USC6 dearer to easier by USC12.

**Lower Medium** – Were irregular with some teas appreciating by up to USC12 while others shed up to USC10.

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
